The Prent facility was operational and helping the community recover less than a week after the destruction. The event sought to empower Medtronic's staff and suppliers to strengthen their Business Continuity Plans and prepare for events threatening their operations. The audience included Dominican Republic government staff, community leaders, Medtronic Corporate and plant staff from the Caribbean, and key suppliers.

Prent Expands Operations

Prent Corporation is planning to expand its operations to include a 37,000-square-foot facility in Rosarito, Mexico. Prent Baja, planned to be operational early next year, is designed to meet the growing demand for Prent's medical packaging regionally while strengthening its global footprint that supports the medical industry from the Americas to the Caribbean, Europe, Southeast Asia and beyond.

The new facility will be an ISO 13485-certified manufacturing plant featuring a certified clean room environment. As part of Prent's vertical integration strategy, the Baja facility will access Prent's Global Package Design Teams, Worldwide Machine Build and Custom Tool Build facilities, ensuring consistent, high-quality performance in Mexico.

The facility advances Prent's corporate strategy to locate its manufacturing facilities in close proximity to its customers, reducing both lead time and transportation costs.



How Prent Corporation Prepares for Trade Shows

If you attend a major industry trade show this quarter, it's almost certain you'll find Prent has an exhibit there. For those who do not know what goes into a trade show, Prent's VP of Product Development Don Handrow breaks down what Prent does to prepare:

- **» Every 3 years:** We build an entirely new booth in our signature, corporate colors for the most well publicized and attended medical device trade shows in North America. The idea is to stay current each year with a new design, Handrow says. Prent showcases smiliarly branded booths of different sizes at all other trade shows.
- **» 12 months out:** We select the trade shows we plan to attend and book booth space. Prent usually exibits annually at MD&M East and MD&M West in North America; HealthPack; COMPAMED, Germany; Medical Technology Ireland; Pharmapack Europe, France; Medtec Europe, Stuttgart; China Med, Beijing; Medtec China; CMEF, China; and biannually at PMMI in North America.
- **» 2 months out:** We set up the display before shipping it to the trade show site to ensure all presents well.
- **» 6 to 8 weeks out:** We order booth services and get any products and literature together for display.
- **» 1 to 2 weeks out:** We prepare name badges, confirm arrival of the display and literature, and conduct pre-show briefing.
- **» After the trade show:** We prepare displays for the next show.

Exhibiting at trade shows allows Prent to visit many customers in the same location and re-energize that personal contact, according to Handrow. "That is the best part of the shows," he says. "We can visit 10 to 20 customers in a very short span that would take us forever to try to get done without the trade shows."

This summer, Prent Corporation received ISO Class 8 Certification for two additional manufacturing clean rooms at its headquarters in Janesville, WI.
